Monterey County Workforce Development Board partners with Monterey Peninsula College in Marina to serve job seekers

Monday, July 12, 2021 – In partnership with Monterey Peninsula College, the Monterey County Workforce Development Board (MCWDB) has opened a new Job Center located at MPC's Education Center in Marina at 289 Twelfth Street, Room 402.

Now job seekers and students can access a variety of employment and training resources, including current job listings, computer and internet access, labor market information and career exploration assessment, online training, career coaching, job search assistance, and resume development. The MCWDB invites job seekers to drop in or call (831) 597-2858 for an appointment.
