Joby Aviation job fair highlights openings for entry-level technicians

September 16, Salinas, CA -- The Monterey County Workforce Development Board is partnering with Joby Aviation, a company developing an electric aircraft, to highlight more than 20 positions the company is seeking to fill for entry-level technicians.

A virtual job fair will be held for Joby Aviation on **September 28, 2021, 4-6pm PDT**, during which attendees can chat with a member of Joby's recruiting team and submit a resume for consideration for Technician positions. It is also an opportunity for attendees to learn more about Joby's electric aircraft and sustainability-focused mission.

Joby is hiring Technicians familiar with electrical wiring and electro-mechanical assemblies for its expanding facility in Marina, CA. Minimal experience is required.

"We're excited to work with Joby to match Monterey County job seekers with full-time positions in the rapidly-developing electric aviation industry," said MCWDB Executive Director, Christopher Donnelly. "This is an exciting opportunity for Monterey County, and our Career Center is here to help job seekers prepare for new careers and find rewarding jobs."

Founded in Santa Cruz, Joby Aviation is developing all-electric aircraft for a passenger transportation service to be launched in 2024. The company, which employs more than 800 people, recently demonstrated its aircraft can fly [more than 150 miles](#) and is [quieter than most airplanes and helicopters](#) in the air today. Joby recently became publicly-listed on the New York Stock Exchange (NYSE:JOBY) and is working with partners including Toyota, Uber, and the U.S. Air Force to certify its aircraft and ramp up its manufacturing efforts.

"At Joby, we're a mission-driven company. We care deeply about the environment and making aviation more sustainable for the planet and our communities," said Julianne Farrand, Head of People for Joby. "We need hard-working, dedicated technicians to meet our audacious goals and we look forward to hiring many talented Monterey County residents as we grow."

Job seekers must be registered in advance to attend the job fair through the Premier Virtual platform.
