Overview

Provides direct one-on-one services to children with Developmental Disabilities assisting them in gaining communication, social, play, and self-help skills. They collect data and follow guidance of the clinician creating the treatment plan (BCBA)

Requirements

18 years or older

High school Diploma

Pass background check DOD & FBI

Ability to move and play with children

Maybe light lifting while playing

Enjoying working with children, adolescents, and or young adults (up to 24 years old) with special needs.

Reliable means of transportation to get to and from clients' homes (will never be placed with children who live more than a 30 minutes from your location).

Description

Through play and engagement with different activities throughout the session, the Behavioral Technician implements programs to assist children with Developmental Disabilities in increasing their behavioral skills and reducing behaviors of concern. The BT follows the lead and guidance of the clinical team of a BCBA or a Supervisor and a BCBA. Data is collected daily and a note is written at the end of each session. Sessions are conducted at the children's home and in the community with the presence of a caregiver (parent/guardian).
